Summer Details and Schedule 2018

Hours: Basic Day: 8:30-3:30pm; PM extended care at Tilden (Ride Zoom will take kids there and parents pick-up at Tilden): 3:30-6:00. Depending on the trip of the day, you might be able to drop off a bit later.

Weekly Option and Shorter Week (3 day week) Option

Location for Drop-Off and Pick-Up: King Park, Hopkins Street, Berkeley; PM care at the Meadows Picnic Area in Tilden Park

Ages and Number of Kids in Group: 9-13, with youth leaders ages 14 and older (if former campers); 16 or older (if not former camper). We'll have between 16/group.

Fees: \$460/week, with extended care additional \$135/week. Early Sign Up and Multiple Week/Sibling Specials (3 weeks or more)-up to \$110 less/week. Junior Counselor Youth Leaders pay a greatly reduced fee. Scholarships available.

All field trip expenses covered in the fee, as well as lunch every Tuesday! No need to pack lunch that day.

We are so excited for the coming summer! Each week will be a wonderful chance to explore the Bay, meet new friends, hang out with old ones, be unplugged, connect with the great outdoors and build relationships with caring, dynamic staff and youth leaders.

What else can you expect? Lots of visits to park for games, basketball, and more games. Conversation, arts, daily group times when we get to know one another, practice mindfulness, give appreciation, practice random acts of kindness, talk about how to travel with awareness, community mindedness, and safety.
