- 40-Hour Work Week
 - **On Site:** 8:00-4:00. Stay 20-30 minutes later on Wednesdays to check in with staff. No official breaks, except when playshop scheduled (not every day) then staff takes 30 min. break.
 - **Off Site:** About 1 hour. Review google calendar and camper paperwork for upcoming week. Daily e-mail check and upload photo/video to drive taken during camp

We are looking for a responsible, enthusiastic and experienced Group Leader to participate in the creation of a fun, enriching, and safe field trip program for a diverse group of boys promoting fun, community and love of travel. The Group Leader will assist the Site Director who oversees the daily camp activities, such as leading campers on field trips, taking public transit, and hosting workshops. Each session is one week long, with many boys returning for multiple weeks. Each session is a maximum of 16 boys, ages 9-13. The group also includes one volunteer Junior Counselor, who you help mentor.

- 1-2 experiences working in a recreational setting with at least 6 children in this age group. *You must have experience for this position!*
- Creative, proactive, playful, flexible, a Yes attitude and PASSION for working with kids
- Ability to remain calm and at ease in high intensity situations
- Excellent communication skills
- Strong commitment to diversity and creating a caring environment for campers of various backgrounds
- Proficiency in Google (drive, calendars, docs, etc.)
- Previous experience working in a camp and/or with groups of boys a plus
- Education in child/adolescent development, art, education or related courses of study a plus

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES include, but are not limited to

Curriculum Development/Implementation

- ❖ Implementing the program with the Site Director and volunteer Junior counselor. You will be on-site each day, participating in the program and engaged with campers. There are 2 staff and 1 Junior Counselor for 16 campers.
- ❖ Leading games as kids wait for transport or workshops; contribute your interests; read games and songs handbooks; study Youtube songs and games to lead.

Supervisory

- ❖ Setting appropriate boundaries to promote campers' emotional and physical health. This program takes place out in public space and travel is by public transport, so special attention to safety is a must.
- ❖ Reading forms that parents have filled out to understand certain special needs.
- ❖ Co-creating a team teaching atmosphere that is fun, respectful, cooperative, and supportive.
- ❖ Being a role model for the boys.
- ❖ Insuring proper care and storage of camp materials, such art supplies and games.
- ❖ Assist Site Director in daily camp activities and receive coaching from Site Director or Staff Director as needed or requested.

Communication

- ❖ Positive communication with parents/caregivers, who drop off and pickup their children/teens daily
- ❖ Exhibiting sensitivity to different cultural, socioeconomic, and emotional background.
- ❖ Guiding each camper to become aware of himself as an individual and as part of a group
- ❖ Using positive conflict resolution and discipline in accordance with the philosophy of the camp.
- ❖ Respectful communication with community that we come into contact with during our field trips.
- ❖ Promoting Monkey Business Camp's programs to current clientele and potential customers.

1. Commitment to working onsite 3 weeks during June 19 – 23, June 26 – 30, July 10-14.
2. Attendance at staff orientation on Sun June 18, 1:00-5:00 pm
3. Leadership training for 2-3 hours outside the all staff training.

4. Read camp details and review website prior to starting camp- about 3 hours.
5. CPR and First Aid certification: We will reimburse \$25/class toward these 2 year certifications.
6. TB Negative Test Result from past 4 years within two weeks of being
7. Filling out end of summer evaluation.
8. Police clearance to work with children

PAY

3 week summer salary will be determined on the hourly range of \$14-18.50/hr depending on education, experience and years at our camp.
